

Grants 15-1

Terms and conditions

- 1- This document sets out the terms and conditions for the award of 15-1 scholarships, intended for European trainees at the Académie Internationale de Musique de Paris.
- 2- The 15-1 scholarships are intended to promote young European musical talent, through the award of a scholarship to support their enrolment in the sessions of the Académie Internationale de Musique de Paris.
- 3- The scholarships are financed by the Académie and 15-1 Diffusion, partner and sponsor of the Académie.
- 4- The amount awarded individually is between 300 and 400 euros, depending on the number of scholarships awarded each year.
- 5- Conditions of attribution. Grants are awarded by a selection committee held annually at the Académie. The committee is made up of professional musicians, Academy managers and representatives of the partner organization. Its decisions are final and without appeal.
- 6- Award criteria: to be eligible for a grant, the following prerequisites must be met:
 - a) European Citizenship
 - b) Residence in Europe
 - c) Under 25 years of age on January 1st of the current year
 - d) Demonstrated artistic potential and aptitude for a professional career in this sector.

7- Award procedure

- a) The candidate must be regularly registered for the relevant session of the academy and have paid the registration deposit.
- b) When registering, he/she must indicate that he/she wishes to apply for a scholarship by ticking the appropriate box on the online form.
- c) Candidates must send their application by e-mail to contact@aim-paris.fr, including official document proof of nationality and residence
- d) proof of identity
- e) free artistic dossier, including details of studies completed or in progress, artistic awards obtained, recommendations from teachers or artists, artistic audio and/or video supports.
- 8- Candidates are informed of the committee's decisions before the end of June of the year concerned, and at the latest before paying the balance of their enrolment.
- 9- Applicants not selected for a grant may cancel their application and receive a refund of their deposit. Refunds are immediate.
- 10- Candidates selected for a scholarship have their registration fees automatically reduced by the amount of the scholarship awarded. The Academy will inform them of this.
- 11- Each scholarship holder will also receive a gift of a pair of top-of-the-range Mauboussin EyeWear eyewear, to be chosen from the distributor's catalog.
